Description

This message occurs when a duplicate IP address is detected on more than one iSCSI interface. Only one of the interfaces is sent as an iSCSI target portal.

Corrective Action

Delete all but one of the iSCSI interfaces which share an IP address.

Syslog Message

Vserver '%s' iSCSI interface '%s' has the same IP address '%s' as another iSCSI interface. This interface will not be sent as an iSCSI target portal.

Parameters

vserver (STRING): Vserver containing the iSCSI interfaces.

interface (STRING): Interface that contains a duplicate IP address.

ipAddress (STRING): IP address that was duplicated.

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
