Description

This message occurs when a directory traversal task cannot finish because of an unexpected error.

Corrective Action

Ensure all nodes in the cluster are online and healthy, and that all volumes needed for the directory traversal are online. Then retry the operation.

Syslog Message

Parameters

volume_dsid (LONGINT): DSID of the volume that encountered the error.

task (STRING): Description of the task that could not be performed.

error (STRING): Description of the error that occurred.

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
