Severity

ERROR

Description

This message occurs when there is an export check failure due to, either export-policy configuration not allowing access, or a non-existing filesystem/junction access attempt.

Corrective Action

Check the export policy configuration or filesystem name depending on the reason due to which export access check failed.

Syslog Message

Export access check failed on Vserver %s for client %s, trying to access volume %s, having policy %s, via protocol %s. Reason: %s

Parameters

vserver (STRING): Name of the Vserver where the issue occurs.
clientIP (STRING): Client for which the export access check failure happened.
volumeName (STRING): Volume name for which export access check failed.
policyName (STRING): Name of the export policy from which export access check failed.
protocol (STRING): Access protocol used by client for filesystem access.
reason (STRING): Reason for which export access check failed.

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
