Description

This message occurs when a shelf firmware module is rebooted administratively, or when a reboot occurs normally when the system powers up, the firmware is updated, or the alternate control path (ACP) is reset.

Corrective Action

module (STRING): Module designator (A or B).

Description

This message occurs when a shelf firmware module reboots unexpectedly (not due to powering up, a firmware update, an alternate control path (ACP) reset, nor an administrative reboot).

Corrective Action

Check the cabling to the shelf. Check the status LED on the shelf, making sure that the fault LEDs are not on. Clear any fault condition, if possible.
