Description

This message occurs when the system cannot determine the stack ID for a disk shelf. The system has exceeded the maximum number of times it can change the stack ID of the shelf. The cause of this issue is a misconfiguration in the system.

Corrective Action

Run the 'system health alert show' command and resolve all of the issues reported by following the corrective actions provided.

Syslog Message

Stack ID of the Shelf %d (S/N %s) on channel %s cannot be agreed on by all the nodes in the cluster.

Parameters

shelfIdent (INT): ID number displayed on the disk shelf OPS panel.

serialNumber (STRING): Serial number of disk shelf.
