Description

This message occurs when a volume is offline during a non-disruptive upgrade operation.

Corrective Action

Bring the volume online prior to next nondisruptive upgrade operation.

Syslog Message

Volume "%s" in SVM "%s" not online during a nondisruptive upgrade operation. For upgrades of this cluster to a version more than "%d" releases later than "%s", the nondisruptive upgrade operation will be blocked if the volume continues to be offline.

Parameters

volumeName (STRING): Name of the volume.

svmName (STRING): Name of the storage virtual machine (SVM).

upgradeLimit (INT): Upgrade limit.

fsVersion (STRING): File system version.

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
