Generate the NDMP user password

Protocols NDMP svms svm.uuid passwords user endpoint overview

Generates and retrieves the password for a given NDMP user in the SVM context.

Examples

```
GET "/api/protocols/ndmp/svms/ca8e29e0-e116-11ea-876c-0050568ea754/passwords/ndmpuser"
```

Generate and retrieve the password for an NDMP user

```
GET /protocols/ndmp/svms/{svm.uuid}/passwords/{user}
```

Introduced In: 9.9

Generates and retrieves the password for the specified NDMP user.

Parameters

Name	Type	In	Required	Description
svm.uuid	string	path	True	SVM UUID
user	string	path	True	User name
fields	array[string]	query	False	Specify the fields to return.

Response

ONTAP Error Response codes

Error code	Description
65601536	The operation is not supported because NDMP SVM-aware mode is disabled.
65601560	An NDMP-specific password is not supported for authentication type "plaintext_sso".

SVM, applies only to SVM-scoped objects.

Name	Type	Description
_links	_links	
name	string	The name of the SVM. This field cannot be specified in a PATCH method.
uuid	string	The unique identifier of the SVM. This field cannot be specified in a PATCH method.

error_arguments

code	string	Argument code
message	string	Message argument

returned_error

Name	Type	Description
arguments	array[error_arguments]	Message arguments
code	string	Error code
message	string	Error message
target	string	The target parameter that caused the error.

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
