Overview

Displays the IP address of the specified hostname and vice-versa.

Retrieving the host table entries

The host-record GET endpoint to retrieve the hostname for a given Ip address and vice-versa.

Examples

Retrieving the hostname for a given IP address.

```
# The API:
GET /api/name-services/host-record/{svm.uuid}/{host}

# The call:
curl -X GET "https://<mgmt-ip>/api/name-services/host-record/77e23bd4-a8fe-11eb-99e0-0050568e14ff/127.0.0.1" -H "accept: application/json"

# The response:

Retrieve an IP address of a hostname

GET /name-services/host-record/{svm.uuid}/{host}

Retrieves the IP address of the specified hostname and vice-versa.
