Quality of Service Options

A QoS option represents a configuration detail that is used by QoS.

Examples

Retrieving a QoS option from the cluster

The following example retrieves the QoS option in the cluster.

```
curl -X GET "https://<mgmt-ip>/api/storage/qos/qos-  
options?return_timeout=0" -H "accept: application/json" -H "Content-Type:  
application/json"
```

2) Update a QoS option

The following example shows how to modify the background task reserve policy to 40%.

```
curl -X PATCH "https://<mgmt-ip>/api/storage/qos/qos-  
options?return_timeout=0" -H "accept: application/json" -H "Content-Type:  
application/json" -d "{ \"background_task_reserve\": 40 }"
```

Retrieve QoS options

GET /storage/qos/qos-options

Introduced In: 9.14

Retrieves QoS options. This option is available only at diagnostic privilege level and above.

Related ONTAP commands

- `qos settings cluster-options show`

Introduced In: 9.14

Update a specific QoS option. This option is available only at diagnostic privilege level and above.

Related ONTAP commands

- `qos settings cluster-options modify`
